

Total Mobility

Total Mobility is a door to door national transport scheme involving disability support agencies, taxi companies and local government.

The scheme provides a 50 per cent discount on taxi fares up to a maximum subsidy for eligible participants.

In the Waikato region, the scheme is open to people living within the city or town boundaries of Hamilton, Tokoroa or within the defined Total Mobility zone as specified by Taupo District Council.

Accessible transport

Buses

The majority of the region's buses are fully accessible, with:

- The ability to lower the bus suspension and 'kneel' close to the kerb, providing step-free access
- Specific wheelchair seating area(s). Wheelchair passengers take priority in these areas. Walkers and baby buggies must be folded or removed from this space if a wheelchair passenger boards the bus.

- Wheelchairs must be under 250kg in weight and 80cm in width to travel on the bus.
- Mobility scooters are not permitted on buses
- For those who are visually or hearing impaired, the Orbiter and CBD Shuttle buses have audio and visual systems which announce the next bus stop.
