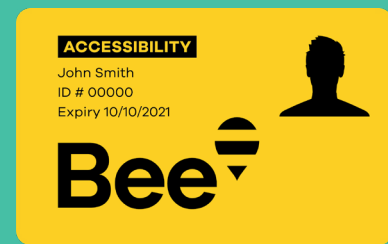


On Monday 6 July, the ticketing system on buses will be replaced with Bee Card.

HERE'S YOUR NEW BEE CARD



It's loaded up with your accessibility concession and is ready to use on the bus from Monday 6 July.

With your Bee Card, all bus travel will remain free.

From Monday 6 July you'll need to tag on and tag off the bus.

- 1 Simply tag on when you board the bus – hold your Bee Card up to the reader, wait for the beep or until you see “tag on successful” and you’re ready to go.
- 2 As you leave the bus, tag off with your Bee Card – hold your Bee Card up to the reader, wait for the beep or until you see “tag off successful” and you’re ready to go.

You no longer have to show your ID to the driver, but the driver can assist with you tagging on and off on their machine if required.

This Bee Card is yours, with your name, photo ID and accessibility concession information printed on it. It can only be used by you. Anyone else travelling with you will have to pay a valid bus fare.

You must abide by the code of conduct of our bus network.
