## The 23 Raglan service connects Raglan to Hamilton.

Get around independently – to the shops, medical appointments, the library, or to visit friends without having to rely on others for a ride – or worry about driving and parking.

So sit back, relax, and enjoy being driven!

### How to use the bus

Please stand at the bus stop and clearly signal to the driver, by raising your arm as the bus approaches.

You will need to pay with cash or with your Bee Card. If paying by cash, please have the correct fare ready. If paying by Bee Card, “tag on” by holding your card to the reader until it beeps.

When you want to get off the bus please press the stop button as you near your stop. Remain seated until the bus stops. If paying by Bee Card, remember to “tag off” by holding your card to the reader until it beeps. Tagging off ensures you’re charged the correct fare.

### ✔ Accessible buses

Buses on this service are wheelchair friendly. The operator always aims to operate accessible buses; however there may be times when this is not possible for operational reasons.

### ✔ Free Wi-Fi

Free Wi-Fi is provided on this bus service - limited to 20MB per day. Terms and conditions of use apply.

### ✔ Transferring to other buses

Transfers onto other BUSIT services are free within half an hour of tagging off weekdays or an hour after tagging off all day on weekends and public holidays. Cash fares do not receive free transfers.

### ✔ Free bike racks

An exterior bike rack is available with room for two bikes at a time. Loading and unloading the bike is the responsibility of the passenger.

### Christmas and New Year

Over the Christmas and New Year period, some services may not operate. Please always check [busit.co.nz](http://busit.co.nz) before travelling over this time.

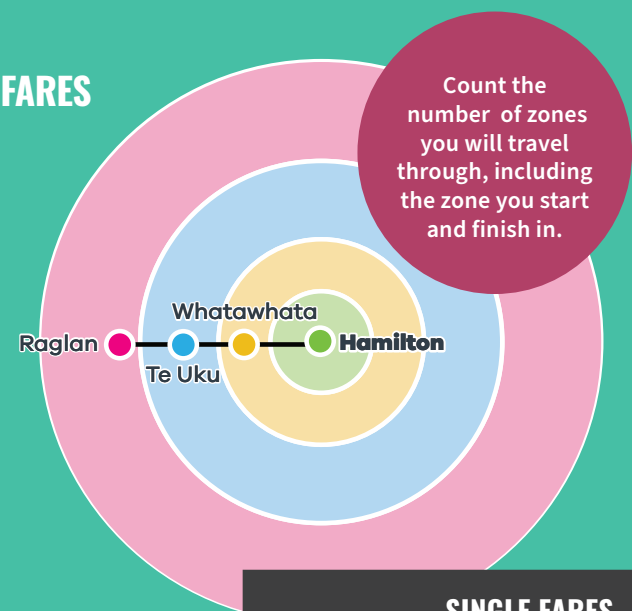
# BEE CARD IS THE BEST WAY TO TRAVEL

There are a number of concessions available for passengers travelling in the Waikato region.

### SuperGold

Card holders with their concession loaded onto their Bee Card receive free travel on any BUSIT service, any time.

Apply for your concession prior to travel.



### Community Services Card

Card holders with their concession loaded on to their Bee Card receive half price travel on any BUSIT service.



### Accessibility Concession

If you have a disability that means you're unable to drive, you may be eligible for free bus travel.

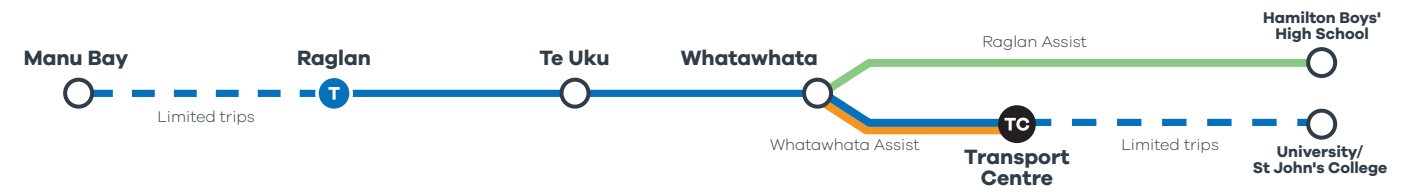

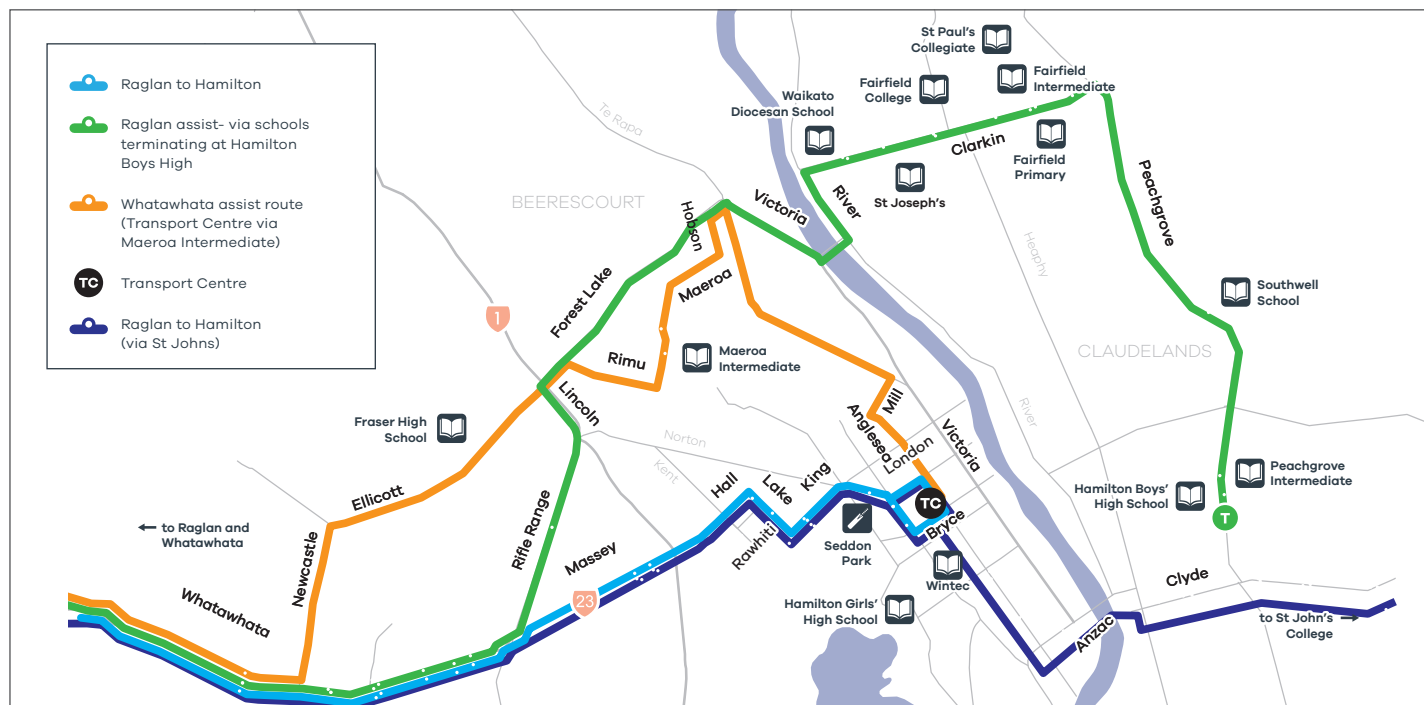
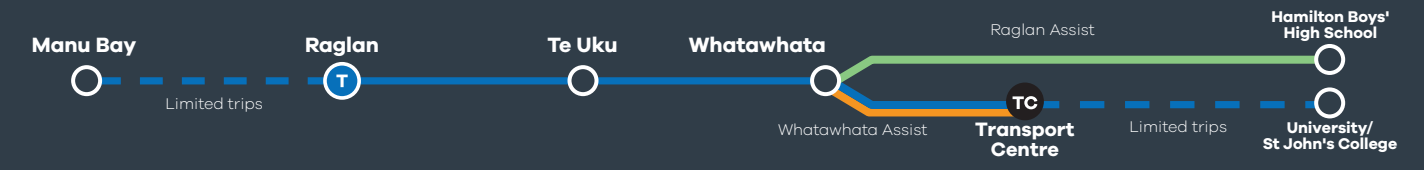

Buses always try to keep to the advertised timetable but times may vary due to traffic and weather conditions. You do not need to book in advance for this bus.



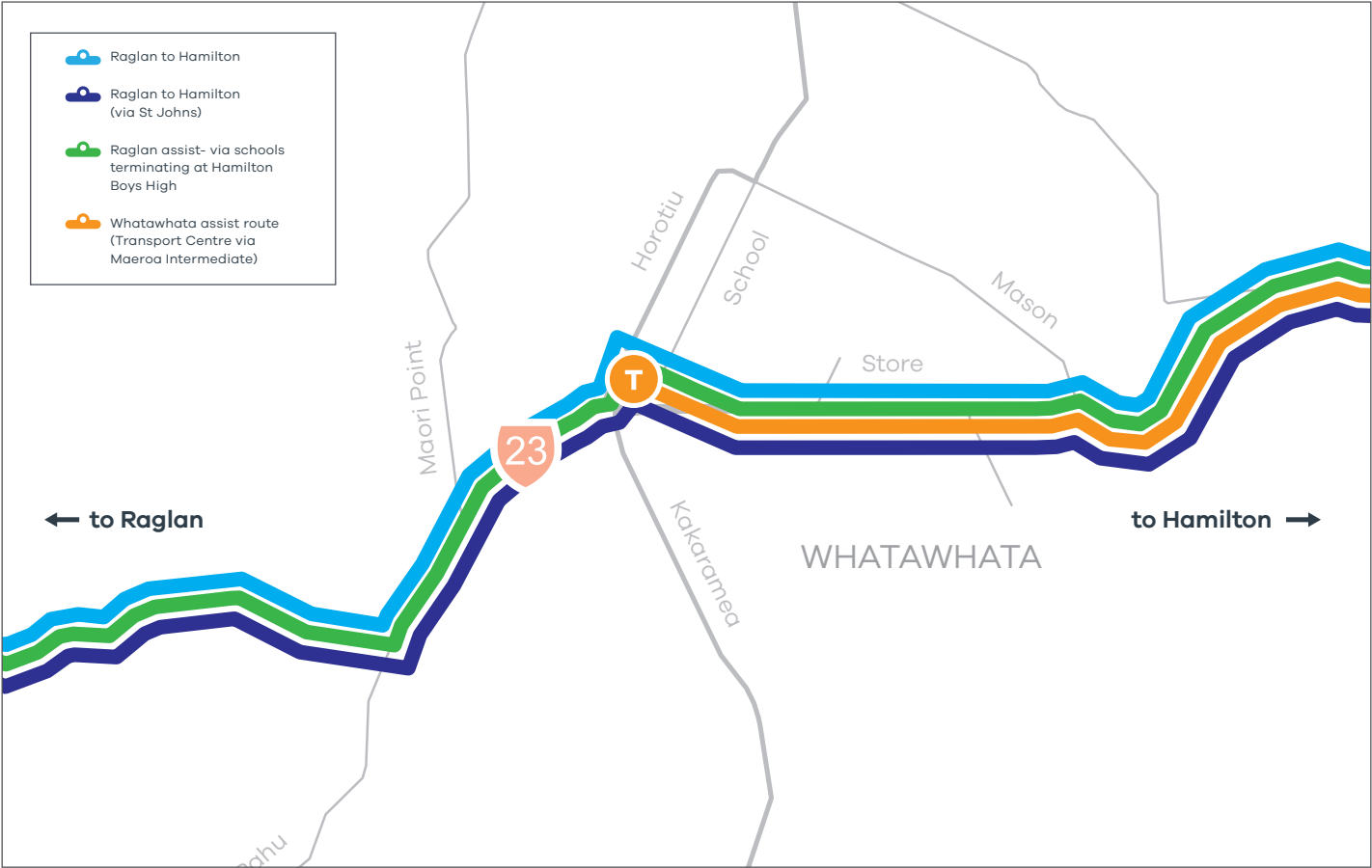
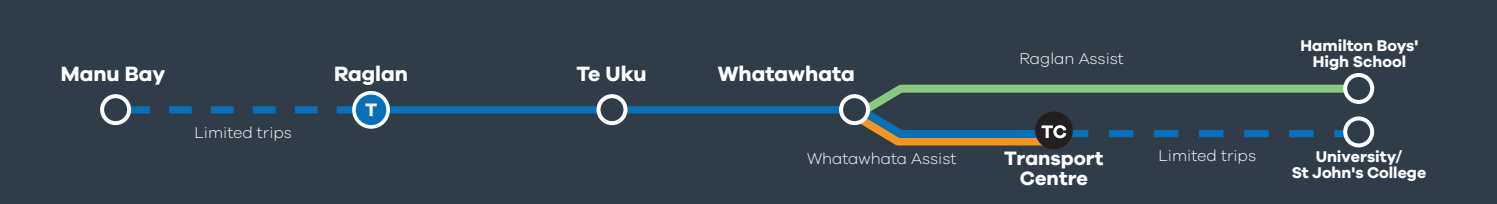
## Route descriptions

**Raglan to Hamilton:** Corner Te Hutewai and Wainui Roads, Whitely St, Norrie Ave, Bow St, Wallis St, Government Rd, Manukau St, Main Rd (State Highway 23 to Hamilton), Horotiu Rd, Store Rd, Whatawhata Rd, Massey St, Hall St, Kent St, Rawhiti St, Lake Rd, King St, Norton Rd, Tristram St, Bryce St for the Transport Centre.

**Manu Bay extension:** Manu Bay boat ramp, Wainui Rd to corner Te Hutewai and Wainui Rd then normal route to Hamilton. Manu Bay extension operates weekends and public holidays between Labour Weekend and Easter, and on limited weekday trips during the summer school holidays.

**Raglan to Hamilton (via St Johns):** Corner Te Hutewai and Wainui Roads (outside fire station), Bow St, James St, Wallis St, Government Rd, Manukau St, Main Rd (State Highway 23 to Hamilton), Horotiu Rd, Store Rd, Whatawhata Rd, Massey St, Hall St, Kent St, Lake Rd, King St, Norton Rd, Tristram St, Bryce St for the Transport Centre. St John's College extension travels from the Transport Centre via Bryce St, Anglesea St, Anzac Pde, Grey St, Clyde St (for Sacred Heart), Knighton Rd, Edinburgh Rd to Hillcrest Rd for St John's College.

This bus will stop on request at all bus stop on route.



**Whatawhata to Hamilton:**

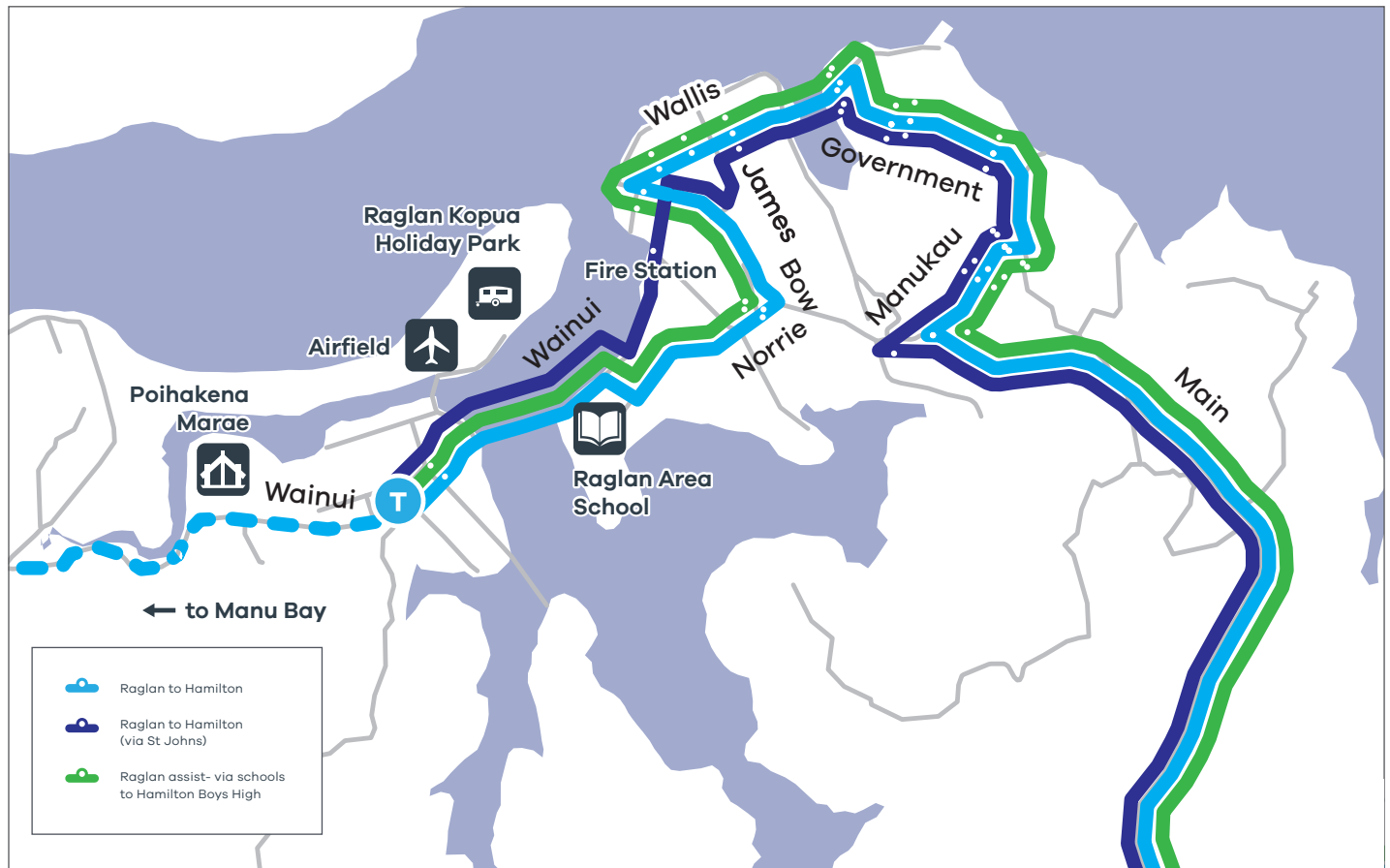
Store Rd, Main Rd (State Highway 23 to Hamilton), Whatawhata Rd, Newcastle Rd, Ellicott Rd, Forest Lake Rd, Rimu St, Maeroa Rd, Ulster St, Mill St, Willoughby St, Angelsea St, Bryce St for the Transport Centre.

This bus will stop on request at all bus stops on route.

**Terminus**

- Manu Bay:** Manu Bay, Wainui Rd.
- Raglan to Transport Centre:** Corner Wainui and Te Hutewai Roads.
- Raglan via St Johns High School Hamilton:** Corner Wainui and Te Hutewai Roads.
- Whatawhata:** Store Road.
- Hamilton:** Hamilton Transport Centre/St John's College.
- Raglan assist service:** Hamilton Boys' High School.





### Raglan assist - via schools terminating at Hamilton Boys High

(6.45am and 3.25pm services): Corner Te Hutewai and Wainui Roads, Whitely St, Norrie Ave, Bow St, Wallis St, Government Rd, Manukau St, Main Rd (State Highway 23 to Hamilton), Horotiu Rd, Store Rd, Whatawhata Rd, Rifle Range Rd, Lincoln Rd, Forest Lake Rd, Hobson St, Forest Lake Rd, Victoria St, Fairfield Bridge, River Rd, Clarkin Rd (Dio, St Joseph's,

Fairfield Intermediate), Peachgrove Rd (Southwell, Peachgrove Intermediate, Hamilton Boys' High School).

Please note this bus does not travel to the Transport Centre, and there are no pick-ups within the Hamilton City Boundary.
