

# The 25 Taumarunui bus connects residents with Waikato Hospital and Hamilton, via Te Kuiti and Otorohanga.

It is a joint initiative between Te Whatu Ora - Waikato (formerly Waikato DHB) and Waikato Regional Council to extend the existing health shuttle to other users.

The Taumarunui service is great for getting to Te Kuiti, Otorohanga or Hamilton for:

- · visiting friends and whanau
- · getting to the shops
- · leisure and sightseeing

This bus is wheelchair friendly.

The 25 Taumarunui service provides a convenient, accessible and comfortable ride. So sit back, relax, and enjoy being driven!

# Hospital appointments

If you are using the Taumarunui bus to get to an appointment at Te Kuiti, Taumarunui or Waikato Hospitals, your trip is free.

Please book your place on the bus via Te Whatu Ora - Waikato (formerly Waikato DHB). Details on how to do this will be included in your appointment letter. Please bring your appointment letter with you to show the bus driver.



# **FARES**

# The Taumarunui bus uses the Bee Card ticketing system and does not accept cash

## **PURCHASING A BEE CARD**

Bee Cards are \$5 and can be purchased online at beecard. co.nz, from Taumarunui i-SITE, or via any retailer listed on our website - busit.co.nz.



Bee Cards need to be loaded with credit to pay for your fare. This can be done at any retailer or online at beecard.co.nz.

A minimum top up of \$5 is required. Top-ups are not available on the bus.

## **PAYING YOUR FARE**

Fares are taken onboard the bus by 'tagging on' to the ticket machine when you board, and 'tagging off' the ticket machine when you leave.

Tagging off is important to ensure the correct fare is taken. Failure to tag off will mean you are automatically charged the highest default fare.

Fares are calculated using a fare zone system. Please use the zone map and fare table on the next page to calculate your fare.

# CONCESSIONS

There are a number of concessions available for passengers travelling in the Waikato region.

# Apply for your concession prior to travel.

## **SuperGold**

Card holders with their concession loaded onto their Bee Card receive free travel on any BUSIT service, any time.



## **Community Services Card**

Card holders with their concession loaded on to their Bee Card receive half price travel on any BUSIT service.



## **Accessibility Concession**

If you have a disability that means you're unable to drive, you may be eligible for free bus travel.






The bus terminates at the Hamilton Transport Centre, from here you can connect to most other BUSIT services to get around Hamilton or to towns such as Raglan or Huntly.

### How to use the bus


Please stand at the bus stop and clearly signal to the driver, by raising your arm as the bus approaches.

Have your Bee Card ready with you to "tag on" by holding your card to the ticket machine until it beeps.

When you want to get off the bus please press the stop button as you near your stop. Remain seated until the bus stops.

Remember to "tag off" by holding your Bee Card to the ticket machine until it beeps. Tagging off ensures you're charged the correct fare.
